Dear Parents/Carers.

Welcome back to our returning children and a very warm welcome to our new children. So far, all the children seem to be settled and happy to be back – it is lovely to see how much they have grown over the summer.

Absence procedures.

Please could you let the nursery know, either by telephone or by speaking to a member of staff, if your child is going to be absent for any reason. On some occasions we have to contact you if your child is unwell. Unfortunately this presents as **No caller ID** on your phone. If this happens to you within your child's nursery hours, I would ask as a precaution for you to call the nursery to check.

Toileting

Please can I remind parents to take their children to the toilet before the start of each session.

Health and Wellbeing

One of our nursery children has a <u>compromised immune system</u>. As a preventative health measure I ask parents to inform Mrs Gray <u>immediately</u> if they suspect their child to have an infection that requires medical attention.

Toy Fund/snack

We would ask that you place your child's weekly payment of£2.50 in the small plastic pouches provided (each pouch will have your child's name on it) and place the sealed pouch in our "Post Box" which will be located on the wall outside of our nursery classroom. Please remember to have the correct money. If you have any problems with this then please speak to Mrs Gray who will be only too happy to explain further. Thank you for your co-operation.

Rag Bag Indoor Textile Bank

Our nursery has registered to participate in the Rag Bag Scheme. As part of our recycling initiative we have decided to involve our children in the Rag Bag Bank, located in the nursery hall. We will distribute bags for children and parents to fill.
