Curricular hformation

Term 4: April—June 2019

Class: P2/1

Literacy

P1 have made wonderful progress with sounds, digraphs and blends. They are now focussing on writing, with a particular emphasis on independent writing. P2 are continuing to progress well across all areas of Literacy and are particularly enjoying writing imaginative stories for their Fairyland topic.

Numeracy

This term the class will explore how to create a simple bar graph using data they have collected. P2/1 will also continue to explore fractions as they explore how to



share objects fairly between friends and learn how to make halves and quarters (P1) and quarters and thirds (P2). Following on from this we will continue to learn how to 'skip count' by 2's, 5's and 10's.

Additionally, the P2's are going to begin looking at multiplication and division. Both groups should continue to practise number formation as much as possible as part of home learning.

Sciences, Social Studies and Technologies

Primary 2/1's Term 4 topic is "Fairyland". They received a letter from a friendly dragon, asking for their help to make people believe in Fairyland again! Pupils will be reading lots of fairytales, writing their own stories, and creating lots of wonder-

ful things to turn our classroom into a magic Fairyland! The class are all really enjoying this topic so far!



Health and Wellbeing

This term P2/1 will continue to work through our PATHS programme. They will be exploring different emotions and learning to identify and share how they are feeling. They will also be exploring what makes us unique as part of SHRE lessons.
