Literacy

This term we will be exploring different types of non-fiction. We will learn to identify a range of features of a non fiction text such as contents, index, glossary, headings and sub-heading and use these to help us find information quickly and effectively, In writing we will be working on functional writing eg, letters, reports, instructions and we will learn how to effectively include information in a poster to capture an audience.

Numeracy

This term we will be learning about different kinds of ways to display information, eg. Bar graphs, tables, venn diagrams. We will also be learning how to work out the area of 2D shapes. In numeracy we will be revising and expanding our knowledge of times tables and using these to help us explore the links between division and multiplication. Also linked to division will be fractions, we will learn about halves, quarters and thirds.

Sciences, Social Studies and Technologies

The focus of our interdisciplinary learning topic will be 'The Library'. P4/3 will be going on a mission to ensure everyone in the Thornwood family has a library card and we will be encouraging them to make use of their local library as much as possible. We will be conducted surveys and record our data, learn about library services and advertise these to our school community. We will also be learning about the importance of libraries and books around the world.

Health and Wellbeing

In Term 2 we will continue to work through our PATHS programme. We will focus on self control, anger management and problem solving. This will include learning about PATHS three steps for calming down.

P.E.

We will be doing athletics in P.E this term and working on our fitness with circuit training.

Religious and Moral Education

This term in RME we will be exploring the gods worshipped by different religions and learning that while some religions have one god, others have many. We will also be revisiting the Christmas story in December.

Expressive Arts including:

Music Primary 4/3 will be working with YMI music this term and have the opportunity to explore rhythm and beat using voice and musical instruments.
