Afternoon session: dropping off between 1 and 1.15

Children must be off the premises by 4 o'clock.

Please make sure your child does not run around the hall - children must be supervised at all times. Workmen will also be

in hall and playground for much of the time – please be extra vigilant.

We would like to reassure you that our playrooms are set up and ready for the children returning. Gymnastics and outdoor play will continue as normal. If you have any concerns please speak to a member of staff.
