Toy fund and gymnastic payments

Please remember that these are collected on a Tuesday - at 11.30 for morning children and 1 o'clock for afternoon children.

The toy fund is a voluntary contribution - however, we do rely heavily on it to fund the snack, party foods, outings, birthday and graduation gifts for the children and it does allow us to renew aging resources.

The gym fund is not voluntary once you have decided you would like your child to participate. We have to pay the gym teacher each week and must therefore request that these payments are made on time. We found that last session a lot of staff time was spent chasing gymnastic money. Mrs Fleming has worked out how much it would cost to pay until the end of term - if you would like to do this please speak to her on Tuesday.

<u>Planning</u>

Our planning will start on Monday of this week. This will be a short and relatively simple plan as we are still settling our new children. The plans will be displayed on the cloakroom wall. If you feel able to help with the plan in any way please speak to a member of the nursery staff. A home link letter will be sent home each plan - this contains some ideas for you to do with you child to support the plan.

At the end of each planning block, you will be invited to come to nursery and to look through your child's folder. Please be aware that this is not an individual appointment to discuss progress - it is a time to share with your child their learning - they should be able to look through their folder with you and tell you what they have been learning. If you have any concerns we will always make time to speak to you, but this is better done at a different time.

These are the proposed times for this plan - but of course if these do not suit you then just ask your child's key worker and we will make an alternative arrangement. (Please return at 11.20 for morning children and any time before 3.45 for afternoon children)
