Class: Primary 5

Literacy

Writing: This term P5 will start by continuing to explore persuasive writing, and they will look into poetry. As well as this pupils will be focusing on poetry that uses Scots language.

These skills will be further enhanced through active spelling and grammar. **Reading**: This term our class novel will be "The Land of Roar", through this the class will make links to art and drama. They will be using Film Literacy to expand on their reading strategies as well as discussing different features of film. **Listening & Talking**: The pupils will continue to develop these skills through whole class discussions, group work and topic-related activities. There will be a focus on reasoning skills.

Numeracy

This term P5 will begin by learning about fractions, and will then move onto decimals. Alongside this pupils will be developing their knowledge of word problems and problem solving skills. There will also be a focus on time this term.

Sciences, Social Studies and Technologies

Primary 5 will begin the term by taking part in a two-week topic focussed on Digital Citizenship. They will explore how to use media and technology safely and responsibly.



Our second topic this term is "Island Explorer". P5 will be learning about a real life sustainability issue that faces communities in St Vincent and the Grenadines, and we will work towards designing a solution that considers renewable resources.

Health and Wellbeing

This term P5 will be continuing to use PATHS to explore healthy communication skills and navigating friendships. In addition to this they will learn about what it means to be an active, respected and responsible individual.

P.E.

This term pupils will continue to receive swimming lessons. In our regular PE lessons pupils will be focussing on basketball, hockey as well as learning traditional Scottish Dances.

Religious and Moral Education

This term the class will be learning about Hinduism and Sikhism, expanding on their knowledge of different religions around the world.
